Opening Ourselves to Social Action: This Month – Earth Day: "Our Power, Our Planet"

"But ask the animals, and they will teach you, or the birds in the sky, and they will tell you; or speak to the earth, and it will teach you, or let the fish in the sea inform you. Which of these does not know that the hand of the LORD has done this? In his hand is the life of every creature and the breath of all mankind." Job 12:7-10

What does *power* mean to you? Does it have religious, political, monetary, career, or materialistic influences? Or maybe some, or all, of the above.

This month we are focusing on the **power needs** of the earth, of our existence, of our future, and *Climate Justice for ALL People*. Pretty important stuff! United Women in Faith continues to emphasize our concerns for the world God has created, and our responsibility to educate, encourage, and lead in efforts to save the planet.

On April 22, 2025, the Earth Day theme is, "Our Power, Our Planet." The organizers ask us to consider different sources of power besides the easy answer: fossil fuels.

Even though the United States, as a country, no longer supports the Paris Climate Agreement, we can do our part to provide information about the uses of alternative energy sources whenever possible. We can survey our communities, homes, and churches, looking for better ways to use energysaving devices.

The most recent U.S. goal for this 55th anniversary year of Earth Day is to triple renewable energy resources by 2030, including solar, wind, geothermal, hydroelectric, and tidal energy.

There seems to be a backlash recently concerning windmills, solar panels, and electric vehicles. And there is so much misinformation available. We need to make sure we look for reliable sources for facts. Tax incentives will probably disappear, so we may have to invest more money ourselves to show our support for saving the planet.

Plan an event for your unit: a Bible study (the above passage is one); energy surveys online to evaluate your homes and churches; find accurate information concerning alternative energy resources for a panel discussion; check for a local speaker who can share tips with the group; many videos are available.

LOCAL UNIT SPOTLIGHT

Christ Church (Kettering) United Methodist Prayer Shawl Ministry is celebrating a milestone 20 years in ministry. This ministry has blessed many over the years. Starting in March 2005 by Arlene Akerman and Doris Kennicott and 5 other ladies who believed in its mission, the original group grew and increased to a loyal, enthusiastic group. These dedicated knitters and crocheters have religiously

met on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday mornings these past many years. Their fellowship involves an opening Blessing, sharing their joys and concerns, the request of shawls for those in need, the exchange of ideas, sharing of patterns and then closing with a corporate blessing of the completed shawls, lap robes and baby blankets received. A special tag is included which explains the significance of the Prayer Shawl/Lap Robe and offers a prayer for their comfort. Eventually a Wednesday night group was started

about 12 years ago led by Elaine King meeting the 2nd and 4th weeks of the month. It is a small but mighty group as well.

The Christ Church United Women in Faith realized the merits of this ministry and has designated it as a Special Interest Group.

They have generously provided the funding for the purchase of our yarn. Over the past 20 years, the ministry members, ministerial staff, members of the congregation as well as word of mouth have contributed to the provision of over **4210** of shawls, lap robes and over **500** baby blankets to those in need. In addition, we have provided shawls and lap robes to Hospice of Dayton, the local hospitals, and Mercy Manor. Baby blankets have gone to new babies in the congregation as well as to Wesley Center of Dayton for their Baby Showers. We also provide a Wedding Shawl to members who are wed in our church. To date our shawls have been delivered to those in need in 48 states, the District of Columbia and 9 foreign countries

We have often heard of the blessing these Prayer Shawls provide. Comments like "This beautiful shawl is a testament to God looking over me", "It is so warm and cozy", "I feel all the prayers said for me" " It has brought me so much comfort when I needed it most."

These handmade knitted and crocheted Gifts have truly been an offering that has changed lives through the transforming power and love of Christ.
